ranquil and serene, this finely detailed bathroom by Westport designer, Gilles Clement of House of Clement offers spa-like amenities in a peaceful residential setting.

Located in Greenwich, Connecticut, the space boasts a thoughtful mix or textures and finishes with rich color and an infusion of organic elements. The double vanity features aqua textured glass vessel sinks atop a finely detailed mahogany wood shelf. Thomas O'Brien sconces provide light for the vanity below. The beautiful grain of the wood shines through its warm stain and appears as if there's movement within its surface, much like the wall behind it.

Inspired by an Asian spa, Mr. Clement chose a color palette of graphite and light gray accented with pops of aqua. Split-level imported tiles were used on several of the accent walls, running from ceiling to floor. Glass mosaic tiles were set at eye level while walls are finished in a high gloss gray concrete. Dark natural pebbles make up the shower floor and are visible through the frameless shower door. The heated floor is covered in 24" x 24" gray ceramic Italian tiles. Polished nickel hardware was used in the space.

To display his clients' lovely collection of Buddha's, Mr. Clement created wall boxes complete with nickel moldings, mahogany shelving and aqua tiles on the back walls. Each are softly lit from recessed lighting above, all of which he placed on dimmers.

While the exterior of the 1930's brick



home may be more traditional in style, Mr. Clement has infused this new space with a more exciting, transitional feel. It's proven to be a perfect choice for a project where "innovation" was a key element in the inspiration of this beautiful new space.
